It is our pleasure to inform you that SEAMEO SEN, Malaysia is calling for research proposals under its Research and Innovation Division activities. Interested Researchers are invited to submit their research proposals before or on 23 July 2021.

Proposed Research Title

Adaptability of Caregiver Skills Training Module in Malaysian Settings

Scope

The research aims to address the importance of Caregivers on having adequate knowledge and skills on children with developmental disorder. The research also should in turn publish a policy paper aimed at promoting the inclusion and participation of caregivers in a more formal capacity building programmes setting.

Duration of Project

The maximum duration of a project is two (2) years including submission of research report.

Research Funding

SEAMEO SEN will be providing the research funding. All research proposal must include a detailed expected financial implication which will be further deliberated.

Eligibility Criteria

Submission is open to researchers from any local higher learning institutions. Each proposal must have a lead applicant who will be subject to the general terms and conditions for granting.

Rules apply to applicant

- Lead applicant must hold a doctoral degree;
- Lead applicant must have an appointment with a local higher learning institution for (at least) the duration of proposed research project;
- The salary of the applicant cannot be financed from this grant;
- The applicant is responsible for research and financial matters;
- Lead applicant can only submit one proposal.

Proposal Submission

The Research Proposal must be in **English** and shall be presented clearly and submitted together with the following:

- Financial implications
- Curriculum vitae of the lead applicant and research team member(s) involved
- Other relevant materials to support the proposal
